The [National Association for Alternative Certification \(NAAC\)](#) is the professional organization that advocates for standards-driven nontraditional educator preparation leading to effective school staffing. NAAC reviews trends and issues to inform practices and policies relevant to recruitment, preparation, certification, support, assessment and retention of high performing educators.

[NAAC members](#) represent nontraditional preparation programs in 37 states. NAAC members are primarily teacher educators, including **university-based** administrators and faculty in alternative certification programs, administrators of programs based in **school districts, non-profits**, including Educator Service Centers, and **for-profit/private programs**. The Members also include state department of education officials, policymakers, and college of education faculty, school administrators, and leaders of non-profit educational organizations. All share a common goal: seeking the best ways to recruit and prepare highly effective teachers who will impact student achievement in meaningful ways.
